Thank you for working with The Barker Adoption Foundation to support our families in the early stages of attachment and placement! Please follow the below instructions when completing a post adoption report for a family who placed through a Barker program.

1. Please reference our Exempt Provider webpage for Barker's report templates and other useful information. All post adoption reports should be completed using Barker's template, though agencies may add any information required by their state.
2. Barker will send an email to each family and their home study agency upon their arrival home with the Post Adoption Report timeline and due dates listed. Dates listed indicate the date by which a draft of the report should be submitted to Barker.
3. All Post Adoption Reports should be emailed as a Word attachment to Barker's International Case Manager [Kellie Olive](#) for edits prior to finalization. PAR edits will be completed and returned to you within 10 business days. For all Barker's International Programs, reports require notarization of all requested copies (Korea 3 copies, India 3 copies). Once reports are finalized, please mail them to the below address:

South Korea

Families adopting from South Korea are required to complete 6 post adoption reports within the 12-month period following custody. The first month's visit **must** be completed within the first 30 days after the family takes custody. Barker will communicate the custody date to your agency prior to the family's arrival home.

Barker's partner agency in Korea requests that all reports be written within 10 days of the visit to the home and submitted to country as soon as possible. **No virtual visits are permitted.**

Barker requests **3 original, notarized copies** be sent to our office upon finalization. Families are responsible for submitting photos directly to Barker.

India

Families adopting from India are required to complete 7 post adoption reports in a 24-month period. The report timeline is based on the family's date of arrival home to the US. **No virtual visits are permitted.**
