A Specialized Recruitment Initiative

**PWNL+** is a targeted effort to recruit permanent families for children with complex medical and developmental needs. In partnership with state agencies, we focus on individualized advocacy and intentional matching to ensure children receive the lifelong support they require.

Program fees are intentionally minimal — most families spend less than \$500 — so resources can be directed toward meeting a child's ongoing care needs.

We invite you to consider whether you, or someone you know, may be the right parent for a child waiting through **PWNL+**.

- Low sensory stimulation
- Steady routines
- Not a high energy home

- Upcoming hip & knee surgeries
- Ongoing therapy support
- Lifelong parenting commitment

## FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Daily care stipend currently provided
- Adoption subsidy available and negotiable
- Most PWNL+ program fees covered

- Experience with autism, cerebral palsy, or intellectual disability
- A strong medical and educational advocate
- A wheelchair-accessible home (or willingness to modify)
